Keeping the lights on at Hampton Court: discoveries from first phases of the ring main replacement project at the Palace

Guy Hunt and Daniel Jackson report on the results of the first two of five phases of works to replace hundreds of metres of electrical cabling within this scheduled monument.

The project is a vital upgrade to the electrical services at the palace and is required to support the future use of the building as a heritage attraction.

For archaeology this project presents a rare and challenging opportunity to excavate within the building revealing earlier phases of the palace both expected and unexpected.
